The top three teams from each pool will advance to Finals. KSHSAA tiebreaking procedures will be applied if necessary. Each advancing team will draw for their competition order. The top four teams from Finals will advance to the State tournament. Plaques will be presented to the Regional Champion and Regional Runner-Up.
