Player Instructions:

- MSHSL Rules apply.
- Please take care of the courses. Repair ball marks, replace divots and rake traps.
- Boys from White Tees.
- Identify your golf balls before teeing off with all members of your group. Please put distinctive marks on you own ball.
- We will highlight each starting hole for the groups since it is a shotgun start. Please be sure to start scoring on the correct hole.
- Course markers:
 - White stakes around course = Out Of Bounds
 - Red stakes – lateral, penalty area
- If you have a rules question and cannot decide on proper procedure, play a second ball for that hole and keep both scores. Coaches will make a ruling when you finish. Declare which ball is your “official” ball. RULING MUST BE OBTAINED BEFORE SIGNING YOUR SCORECARD.
- Please make sure everything is correct on your scorecard before it is signed. An incorrect scorecard will result in a DQ.
- Please Play Ready Golf!!!! Keep up with the group in front of you!
