



Park Hill Doubles Tournament



Hosted at Park Hill and Park Hill South
Wednesday April 8th, 2026

Thank you for participating in the Park Hill Doubles Tournament hosted by Park Hill & Park Hill South! This the 11th year of this event and includes 8 teams in an all-doubles format. Each school will play the other 3 schools in their pool in a head-to-head matchup. After pool play, each team will be seeded 1-4 and will play the corresponding seed from the other pool. A dual will consist of 4 doubles matches. Thus, a minimum of 8 players are required for the event. You are welcome to bring more than 8 players and change your line-up from match to match.

FORMAT: Each school will play 5 duals, 3 in pool play, 2 in semis/finals.

A "dual" will consist of 4 doubles matches (#1, #2, #3, #4 doubles)

All matches will be 8 game pro-sets **with one-ad scoring**. (Note: One-ad means the first time you get to deuce, you play normal ad scoring but if you get back to deuce, it turns into no-ad.) Tie-breakers will be played at 7-7 (to simplify the total games for tie-breaker purposes) in pool play. In the final round, tie-breakers are played at 8-8.

Team scoring during pool play will be determined by:

- 1) Overall team dual record (3-0 is perfect score)
- 2) Overall record for the 12 doubles matches (12-0 is perfect score)
- 3) 1st Tie-Breaker: Head-to-head dual(s)
- 4) 2nd Tie-Breaker: Most number of games won
- 5) 3rd Tie-Breaker: Least number of games lost

Following pool play, each team will be seeded #1-4. The #1 and #2 teams from each pool will play in the championship bracket. The #3 and #4 will play in the consolation bracket. Seeds will cross over (1 Red vs 2 Purple, etc) in the semifinal round. *For the Semis/Finals/Consolation matches, 2-2 ties will be broken by using the total number of games (tie breaker #4 and #5 above). If this is still a tie, the higher seed (#1 or #3) will advance.*

TEAMS: Park Hill, Park Hill South, Liberty North, Grain Valley, Lee Summit North, Blue Springs, Lee's Summit, Barstow
Red Pool (@ PH): Park Hill, Barstow, Lee Summit, Liberty North
Purple Pool (@ PH South): Park Hill South, Grain Valley, Blue Springs, Lee Summit North

TIME: Play will begin at 8:30am. There will be a very brief coaches meeting at 8:20am. Estimating 1.5 hours per round, pool play should conclude by 1pm. A one hour break from 1-2pm will be used to eat lunch and to move locations. The finals will be played starting at 2pm (or earlier if both coaches agree).

LOCATION: Red Pool matches: @ Park Hill High School
Purple Pool matches: @ Park Hill South High School
Finals matches: #1 and #2 seeds will be at Park Hill. #3 and #4 seeds will be at PH South.

TENNIS BALLS: Each school will provide the balls for 2 courts per dual. There are five duals to be played during the day. Thus, eight cans of tennis balls are recommended, but recycling used balls for the 2nd & 3rd rounds of pool is fine.

ENTRY FEE: \$40 per school payable to Park Hill High School

AWARDS: 1st Place Traveling Team Cup. (Winner must return the cup the following year!)
1st & 2nd place medals for the top doubles team at each flight. 1st and 2nd place medals for top teams.
