- ❖ *Blue Tees (white tees for any girls)*
- ❖ **IWanamaker scoring app will be used**
- ❖ *This is your warning regarding swearing, club throwing, hat backwards, or other behavior deemed to be unsportsmanlike (2 stroke). No jeans and or tee shirts.*
- ❖ **LOCAL RULE – UNMAINTAINED AREAS AND TREELINES WILL BE PLAYED AS RED PENALTY AREA**
- ❖ **Out of Bounds** – Defined by the inside points, at ground level, of white stakes.
 - **holes: 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11**
- ❖ **Penalty Area Stakes and Lines** – When a water hazard or lateral water hazard is defined on only one side, it is deemed to **extend to infinity**. When a water hazard or lateral water hazard is bounded by out of bounds, the hazard margin extends and coincides with the out of bounds line.
- ❖ **Red (Lateral) Penalty Area** are marked with RED lines (and Stakes)
 - **Holes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17**
- ❖ **Penalty Area** are marked with YELLOW lines (and Stakes)
 - **Holes: 1, 9, 14, 15, 17, 18**
- ❖ **Ground Under Repair** – Defined by white lines. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair. Ground under repair may include areas of unusual damage, including areas where spectator or cart traffic has combined with wet conditions to affect materially the ground surface, but only when so declare by an authorized member of the Committee. When immediately adjacent to an obstruction, such an area is part of the obstruction.
- ❖ **Abnormal Ground** - If your ball is in the General Area, and there is interference by an Abnormal Ground Condition you may take free relief by dropping the original ball within one club length. **AREAS OF TREE REMOVED AND RESTORATION ARE COVERED BY THIS RULE**
- ❖ **Embedded Ball Through the Green** – Local Rule as prescribed in Appendix I are in effect.
- ❖ **Doubt of Procedure** - If you are not sure of a ruling, discuss with your playing partners, if you are still not sure play two balls mark down both scores then discuss the situation with the Rules Committee at the scoring table who will then make the official ruling.
- ❖ **Spectators** will be allowed on the course, however **THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED THE GIVE ANY ADVICE TO THE PLAYERS, NOR ARE THEY ALLOWED THE GIVE ANY RULINGS, AND SHOULD REFRAIN FROM ANY DIALOG.** Spectators should not look for lost golf balls unless the player asks for assistance. Spectators not conforming to these rules will lose their privilege to watch the match and will be asked to leave the course.
- ❖ **Close of Competition** – The competition is deemed to have closed when the trophy has been presented to the winner or, in the absence of a prize ceremony, when all scores have been approved by the Committee. The result of a match is considered to have been “officially announced” when the Committee has approved the result as posted on Iwanamaker.
- ❖ **Rules Committee** - ALL Coaches are designated as part of the Rules Committee.

Paul Naumann
Brookfield Central Golf
1972 - 1996

Paul Naumann, 88, attended Milwaukee Lutheran High School and Valparaiso University and additionally also earned a Master's degree from UW-Milwaukee. During his years at each school, he was a standout athlete on the gridiron, baseball field and basketball court.

As a multisport athlete at Valpo, some of his records still stand today. The 1957 graduate of Valparaiso University, was a First Team All-Conference honoree on the baseball diamond as a freshman. On the gridiron, Naumann set single-game records that still stand today: touchdowns in a game (4) and points scored in a game (24). During his career he rushed for 1,278 yards (leading the team as a senior in both rushing yards (637) and receiving yards (264). Paul is a member of the Valparaiso University Hall of Fame.

Paul earned offers to play baseball for the Boston Braves, Chicago White Sox and Baltimore Orioles, along with an invitation to the Green Bay Packers training camp. Paul had committed to join the US Marine Corps Platoon Leaders class after college. He continued his sports career, playing for and/or coaching the USMC traveling teams in both football and baseball.

Paul and his wife of 66 years Phyllis, came back to Wisconsin to be near their families, and Paul started his teaching and coaching career which spanned over 38 years between Concordia University Milwaukee, Brookfield East High School, and Brookfield Central High School. During these years of teaching Physical Education, Paul introduced and began an Outdoor Education program which was replicated throughout Wisconsin. He was an instructor for the National P.E. conference and a presenter with the DNR of WI for teacher workshops on the subject. Paul also introduced the sport of pickleball to the schools in the state after attending a conference and learning about it.

Paul coached basketball, football, and golf. His teams found much success, reaching the playoffs multiple times (10 conference championships and 9 trips to state) and earning State Championships in both girls' basketball (1985) and boys' golf (1978). He was also named Wisconsin Coach of the Year in both sports, and inducted into the Hall of Fame for coaching at Concordia, Brookfield Central, and the Golf Coaches Association of Wisconsin.

*Paul started this invite in 1997 as a 9-hole event that was played at Silver Spring CC. His invite has grown into an 18-hole event at Wanaki GC showcasing some of the top teams in the state including 15 State Championship teams as well as 16 State Runner-up teams that competed at this event. With Paul's passing in 2024, we are honored to name this event after him, **The Paul Naumann Brookfield Central Invitational.***
