Welcome to the Class 2A Boys Sectional golf meet located at the Bloomfield Country Club, 1205 E. Franklin St. * Bloomfield, IA

Established in 1921 and celebrating our 105th year this year! The Bloomfield Country Club, located in Southern Iowa, is a beautiful nine hole course. We offer a challenging scenic course that is always well maintained.

Date: Wednesday, May 13

Time: 10:00 am (Coaches meeting at 9:15)

Teams: Albia, Burlington Notre Dame, Davis County, EBF, PCM, Pella Christian, Pleasantville, Regina Catholic, Van Buren County

Coaches Meeting: Located in the clubhouse at 9:15 (a jury of 3 coaches will be selected)

Scorecards: Players shall keep their own card and serve as a marker for all others in the group. At the end of the round, the players then simply compare cards and turn in their own card after it has been attested to by all in the group. Each card requires the signature of all members in the group.

Carts: One cart will be provided for head coaches. A maximum of 2 authorized coaches per school.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome, we will have a spectator meeting before the meet starts to go over rules. NO outside food or beverages brought in

Food/Beverages: Food and drinks will be available for purchase through the clubhouse. Coaches may provide water or sport drinks for the players. Coaches will be permitted to provide a sandwich or energy bar for the players.

Rosters: Please fill out the attached golf tournament entry form and return to Mike Bunnell or Dave Mason. You may golf six and only 4 will score. A school entering less than four players may compete for individual honors only. Entries are due a minimum of four (4) days prior to the event. Please return the entry form by Saturday, May 9th.

KIND OF PLAY: Tournament play will be eighteen (18) holes of stroke play. For all regular season and post season tournament play, the USGA playing rules will be followed unless modified by the local course management. All golf matches shall be played in accordance with the USGA Rules of Golf--The ball shall be played as it lies, except as otherwise provided in the rules.

Postseason Advancement: The sectional team champion, runner-up, and third place team will advance to the district competition. The top two overall individual players (plus ties) at each site from among the non-qualifying teams will advance from each Sectional tournament.

Green Fee: There is a green fee charge of \$15.00 per player, with a max of \$90 per school. Please have this payment with you when you arrive. This should be paid directly to the Bloomfield Country Club. Invoice attached.

Bloomfield Country Club Course Rules

We will play as follows:

- USGA Rules will be followed unless otherwise specified in the IHSAA Golf Manual.
- Blue tees - all 18 holes
- Play the ball down
- Bunkers on #4 - please rake after hitting from them
- Pace of play – record scores on the way to the next hole.
- Keep track of your ball - make sure you're hitting your ball
- Stroke and Distance on Out of Bounds
- Hole #4 - Unmowed grass on left, white poles on left- Will have spotter
- Hole #5 – Fence line to the left through the green - Will have spotter
- Lateral hazards – Holes 1 and 3 - drop zone, add 1 stroke penalty.
- Drop zone on hole #7 on the other side of the pond if the tee shot (or any subsequent shot) goes in water - add 1 stroke penalty.
- Unnatural hazards – No Penalty

Clubhouse patio and parking lot – drop circle on hole #9

Boundary fence hole #5 – drop 2 club lengths no closer to hole

Backstop hole #5 – drop circle

Driveway – drop 2 club lengths to closer side, no closer to hole
