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SCC Academic Bowl Rules

Each round has Toss Up Questions & Bonus Questions.

Toss-Up

- Each toss-up question will be worth 10 points.
- Students have 5 seconds (or 20 seconds for a math question) to buzz in. Any player answering without recognition disqualifies him/her on that question.
- As soon as the player buzzes in, the moderator stops reading the question. **Once recognized by the moderator**, the player must answer immediately.
 - On missed questions, the following rules apply:
 - On an interrupted question only, if the incorrect answer is given, the moderator will repeat the entire question and the other team will have 5 seconds to answer.
 - If the entire question is read and the incorrect answer is given, the other team will have 5 seconds to answer the question; the question will not be reread.
- If there is a question the reader/monitor is not comfortable reading, use the last question in the packet and work your way up.
- In case of a tie at the end of regulation, keep asking a toss-up question until one team wins the match.

Bonus

- Bonus questions will have four parts. Each part will be worth 5 points. The team will have 30 seconds to discuss the answers. A captain may answer all the parts or defer all parts to one player. He/She must answer all parts, and there will not be additional discussion once the captain begins to speak. The timer will give a 5-second warning to the team.
- At any time during the team's discussion, the captain of the team that correctly answered the toss-up question may call "time" to end the conferring period for both teams.
- Once the captain has answered the bonus question, the moderator will say which parts were correct and how many points the team earned. The other team will then have the opportunity to answer any parts missed by the first team without any additional time to conference.
- Readers should finish the bonus question even if time has expired.



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Each round will consist of two periods of twelve minutes or 12 questions each.

Teams may substitute only between periods.

Each break will last two minutes.

The top four teams from each pool will advance to the afternoon rounds. This will be decided on W/L record, head-to-head, points, and then coin toss.

In the afternoon, it is a single elimination. Rankings will be decided by points.

Awards will be given for the top three teams.

Timers:

Rounds are two periods of 12 minutes OR 12 questions. (2-minute break between)

Toss-up questions have 5 seconds to answer (20 for math questions)

Bonus- teams may discuss for 30 seconds

Missed questions- other team has 5 seconds to answer

Readers should finish the bonus question even if time has expired.

It is important to keep the game moving. Each round is scheduled for 35 minutes.

That includes testing buzzers and room transfer time.

Scorekeepers:

You need to keep track of individual and team totals because All-Conference awards are given to the highest scorer from each school and the next competitors to a total of 12. We track scores for all rounds.

After each round, please have the runner take the score sheet to the official scorekeeper in the common area.
